## Universal Periodic Review of Namibia

Liechtenstein welcomes the distinguished delegation of Namibia and wishes to thank for the information provided in the introductory statement and in the national report.

In a constructive spirit, Liechtenstein recommends that Namibia

- 1. Ratify the Optional Protocol to the Convention against Torture,
- 2. Continue its efforts to eliminate all forms of sexual and gender-based violence as well as violence against children, by taking comprehensive measures to investigate, prosecute and punish all forms of gender-based violence and violence against children as well as by addressing obstacles faced by victims and survivors of such violence in seeking remedies and obtaining protection,
- 3. Amend its legislation to abolish provisions discriminating against LGBT persons, including those criminalizing sexual acts between consenting adults of the same gender,
- 4. Follow up on previous recommendations on corporal punishment on children and enact legislation explicitly prohibiting all forms of corporal punishment on children, including at home.
